Thursday Jan 3 -

N.E. Wind, Cold - Fred & I built a corral and  
worked on Cow barn - Mrs McRae & family by  
Mc's Team ran away - Lumber moved onto claim N.E.  
of here

Friday Jan 4 -

NE Wind - Worked on barn Chores, Hay running  
short. Horses feeling good. Henry a big boy

Saturday Jan 5. 1889

Mild Pleasant Hitched up four and went with Fred for load ~~Hay~~ swapped Hay with Kelso Cattle back home late. Fed stock Supper & bed

Sunday Jan 6

Mild Pleasant - Grandm's worked on barn Fred helped - saw C Jones about bull here - Chorus - cleaned barn -

Monday Jan 7

Mild Pleasant. Hitched four to load of ~~Hay~~ and hauled it to Harney for P. Drinkwater who I found sick in bed - also took a sack of Peats to Restaurant. unloaded ~~Hay~~ Supper & bed at P.D.

Tuesday Jan 8

Cold Wind N.E. Breakfast and loaded up 92 posts on Wagon for Dan Curtis hitched up and started for home - which I reached before sundown

Wednesday Jan 9.

Mild Pleasant - worked on barn Hitched up team and hauled Posts to Cattersons

Ida Mary & Hall went as far as Mrs Clark  
to see Mr Woods new baby. I kept on for a  
load Hay at Kelso's stayed over night

Thursday Jan 10th

Mild Pleasant Hitched up team and took  
a load of Posts down to lower corral  
to fix same. Mr Kelso went along and helped  
load Hay - started for home with Hay and  
arrived at Sundown

Friday Jan 11-

Mild, Worked on barn unloaded Hay, chores etc  
Made out notices for school election, clean barn

Saturday Jan 12 -

Cold N.E. Wind with snow. Made bedroom door  
and casing, J Embree was here - heard that  
W Page and Geo Page were met on seven mile  
Hill on Cascade Mts, claimed they were from  
Baker City going to Eugene City to winter  
they were on foot driving two Miserable pony  
both well armed. - chores etc

Sunday Jan 13

Cold N.E wind snow. Finished door chores etc

Monday Jan 14 - 1889

Cold but clear Hitched up 4 horse team and went with Fred for Hay. Mr Kelso better home about one hour after dark coldest ride of the season.

Cold thermometer at zero in house this morn. Milked chores, unloaded Hay. cleaned barn fixed door to pig pen  
Hair Cut

Wednesday Jan 16

Cold Blowing Worked on Horse sled which I find Horses in good shape, cleaned barn

Thursday Jan 17 -

Cold ~~Pleasant~~ snowing hard Hitched up Gyp & Dick to sled and went to Burns for mail &c Paid Taxes for 1888 \$30 Geo Heck stayed over night Bemra came back from town met us

Friday Jan 18 -

Frost but turned Mild & Pleasant Fred started for Kelso's for load of Hay with Jow & Mag Mr Watten was here "says Columbia Poplar" is the best tree for timber culture grows from a cutting and is 70 to 80<sup>"</sup> high Page was here for

Saturday Jan 19

Mild Pleasant Got out Potatoes Went to the school Meeting chores. Fred got home at dusk with load of Hay -

Sunday Jan 20

Mild - Cut and hauled Willow Unloaded  
Hay had got out Ruta bagged chores

Monday Jan 21.

Wind. N.W. with Snow. Concluded not to go  
for Hay. Fixed a door latch and deepened the  
Well. chores

Moderate wind and I went down for a load  
of Hay House caught fire and after some  
trouble put it out which made us late a very  
cold ride home Kelso thinks May will have a cold

Wednesday Jan 23

Moderate fixed the stove pipe saved tips off  
cow Horns chores cleaned barn.

Thursday Jan 24

Cool and Windy Started with load of Hay for  
Harney (4 Horses) delivered same to McKinney  
stayed over night saw Aberson <sup>man</sup> Clark & Woods

Friday Jan 25

Mild Pleasant loaded 100 posts & came home  
shoes taken off horses,

Saturday Jan 26

Warm Pleasant made a wheel for plough chores

Sunday Jan 27 - 1889

Mild Pleasant started with Post for Catterson  
unloaded and went on to Kelso's (4 horses)

Cold snowing & wind - Fixed Dick Haller a rocking chair also  
sewing machine Heard that Vendot's poor baby died ~~youngly~~

Cool Blowing hard Worked on clock cleaned barn  
Ida attended funeral of Roberto baby - Dr Embree here

Cool. Hitched up & and went after hay home at dusk. A sick colt at corral

Mild Pleasant Ploughed in garden for grain  
Harrowed and put in barley need a cutter for Plough

Rain wind & cold Put a window in House - chores  
Fred went to school Ida washed -

Saturday March 9

Cloudy with squalls - Hitched up Dick & Gypsey and went  
to Harry to get a cutter on Plough & - saw Dr. William  
R. Drinkwater, Hudson, &c Home late

Sunday March 10

Raw wind from N.E. My birthday 42 years of age.  
B. Embree's dam broke and the water came down  
at 5 PM

Monday Dec 11, 1889

Mild. Windy. S.W. Hitched four horses to plough  
and started to break land for grain. Fred  
drove ploughed about  $\frac{3}{4}$  acre, seeded same  
with barley and harrowed. Mark Embree here

Tuesday Dec 12 ~~then day~~

Rain in night and through the day  
Fred went to school I fixed window  
Mark Embree here, too wet to plough

Wednesday Dec 13

Rain in night and morning finished window  
which looks good, Fred at school, ground wet,  
Planted acorns, Blk walnuts, Hazel nuts, cherries,  
and Raspberries, along river in garden,  
Dr Embree & Ted Hayes here on school biz  
Ida planted Onion sets, Wash Harkness  
Hog came up at eve and we took him  
in

Thursday Dec 14 —

Stormy occasional squalls. Hitched up 4 horse  
team and ploughed about  $\frac{3}{4}$  acre. seeded  
same and harrowed, Mark Embree, here for  
quinine pills. Wash Harkness Hog still here  
<sup>also</sup>

Friday Dec 15

Stormy looking wild ragged looking clouds with

some wind, hitched up 4 horses and harrowed all plough land and then continued ploughing Blossom brought a nice little heifer for calf which we call Daisy, Wash Harkness came after his hog.

Saturday March 16 -

Windy - Hitched up four horses and ploughed and seeded and harrowed. Attended to Blossom's letter

Sunday March 17

Stormy Fred rode to Burns for mail &c I got out Turnips from Garden did chores. Newbill here - cleaned barn. Horses in good shape

Monday March 18

Rain Rain Rain stayed home cleaned barn

Tuesday March 19

Fine Pleasant. Ploughed, harrowed and seeded Dr. and Mark Embree here - they filed on timber culture and advised me to do the same

Wednesday March 20

Fine Pleasant. Ploughed, harrowed and seeded Mark Embree here also Mrs Newbill after sugar

Thursday March 21.

Fine Pleasant. Mark Embree here I went with him East about five miles and selected Timber Culture N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 28, T.S. 24 S.R. 32 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. W.M. (over)

Thursday Mch 21.89. Continued

Started with Mr Embree for Burns where I sent filings on S.C. to Laterview, home very late 11 P.M.

Fine Pleasant Harrowed and then Ploughed tired from yesterdays trip Henry sick tooth<sup>ing</sup>

Saturday Mch 23rd

Cloudy with High wind Seeded and Harrowed in afternoon ploughed, Storm in Eve. <sup>came from</sup>

Sunday Mch 24.

Cloudy with wind fixed Rolling coulter of plough, Mr Robbins here for Milk & Eggs <sup>50¢</sup>, Ploughed - and Seeded cleaned barn

Monday Mch 25

Fine, Pleasant, Mary's birthday 3 years old. Harrowed and Ploughed a new land, Mrs Mc Kenzie and family here. Took Henry to Dr Embree and got some Med. Fred cleaned barn

Tuesday Mch 26

Fine Pleasant - Ploughed seeded and Harrowed Mr Adler & Mrs Storall here to dinner. Eggs Cleared barn

Wednesday Mch 27.

Mild Windy squalls towards Eve with showers Fred Harrowed and I dug Potholes in Morn, afternoon we ploughed chores &c cleaned barn

Ida sold Eggs 50¢ Thursday March 28. 89.

Mild Pleasant Ploughed sereed & harrowed  
dug 3 Postholes pretty near through with the  
barley.

Friday March 29

Rain & wind wrote letters in forenoon in the  
afternoon Ted harrowed with 4 Horse team and  
I dug 17. Postholes Ida took care of babies

Snow Cold Wind & Hail set Posts and run wire I shot two  
ducks on wing

Wednesday Apr 17

Cool with squalls Run wire finished field.

Warm - Got up horses & ploughed garden. put in Turnips & Pea bags. Scott Hayes here Fred harrowed manure

Thursday Apr 25

Warm Put in Carrots Radish Peas Lettuce parsnips,

Friday Apr 26

Warm Put in Carrots Radish Peas Beets. Mac was here also Dr Embree & wife. 1st brood chickens came off Mag & Jenny making bag. Chisled up. Grubbed.

Saturday Apr 27.

Warm. Grubbed willows squalls and wind in Eve

Sunday Apr 28.

Rained all night and most of the day.

Monday Apr 29. Bertha & Remy <sup>here</sup>

Warm Fred got up horses. Grubbed willows and worked in Garden ploughed for Beets afternoon

Tuesday Apr 30th.

Warm Harrowed ground and planted Beet seed Mrs McKenzie & family were here Mag & Jenny making bag fast

Wednesday May 1, 1889

Windy Cool. All hands put  
in Beet-seed - chores &c

After which Fred and Mac started for the  
Sierra Mountains for a deer hunt - I grubbed  
did chores. Ida went with McKenzie  
part way home and got up the cows  
Horses up river above the Place  
Snodgrass of Nebraska herding back of Place

Friday May 10. 1889.  
Mild Pleasant - Jenny came up in  
night with a fine Mare colt  
which we have named Bay Queen  
Grubbed all day Ida washed -  
A Dutch Lord here looking for Miles  
of ever put Jenny and Queen in barn  
Mares and colts doing well. chores

Saturday May 11.

Warm Put in Potatoes Ida washed  
Cut Mary's Hair she looks well.  
at eve put Jenny and Queen in barn

Sunday May 12.

Cool Windy - Did chores shaved  
went up to N. Robbins, A New town talked of

Monday May 13

Cool Stormey Put in Potatoes  
Fred got home No erosion  
Fired Devine's horses off land  
Fred set out tree cuttings

Tuesday May 14

Cool & Cloudy Commenced to rain  
in Eve - Put in potatoes and  
grubbed Ida & Fred also planted  
potatoes - chores -

Wednesday May 15.

Rained all night, high wind  
got up towards Morning and  
turned to snow - Ground covered  
with the beautiful this morning  
and snowing hard - The Horses up  
I put the mares and colts in the  
barn. Gypsy looking splendid  
and making bag - Between 1 and 2  
inches of slush snow all over the  
country snowed all morning hard  
and rained most of balance of day  
with some wind, Got up wood, chores,

Thursday May 16  
Wild and stormy looking with wind and  
some rain - commenced a trench  
in cow corral also commenced  
the palace, young vegetables all  
coming up nicely Turned the  
mares and colts out as it got  
clearer towards noon, chores

Friday May 17.

Storm Rain & Wind - Made door  
as for Palace - the Dutch Lord  
and a young Lady were here  
for an umbrella, went up to  
Dr. Williams in afternoon to see  
their garden some heavy showers  
Henry got cold and a little  
hoarse Fred got wet - G Hayes  
also, chores. Gypsy making trap

Saturday May 18

Cool Pleasant. Went to Burns on  
dick, Mr Moe went along, got  
mail, filings on timber culture  
also Money for the 80 acres sonoma Co  
300<sup>00</sup>. saw Hendrie about the calves  
got home in good season - chores

Sunday May 19.

Warm Pleasant. Read papers &c  
Ida and children went down to the  
Woods - Fred and I hitched up the  
chuck for first time and had a  
grand circus - he acted very bad  
Hendricks the 2<sup>nd</sup> with Mary &  
Shelley Newbill were here. The  
horses were up all looking well  
the sheep shearers started for Harry

as far as the Harvey Road saw Robbins

W Harkness & Mrs Page rode North,  
court commenced on Monday.  
little Henry can raise off the floor by holding  
onto any ones fingers, how is that for

and Chief and drove to Harvey Pa

Mr Brown left Devine's for East  
in afternoon Fred and I grubbed  
Willows, chores &c

Thursday May 23

Warm Fred brot Potatoes from  
A Robbins and we cut them up  
Ploughed in afternoon and put  
in potatoes brought home wood  
in evening

Friday May 24

Warm Finished putting in the  
potatoes and loaded some wood  
and came home, dug post  
holes -

Saturday May 25

Warm - Bed and I broke clock  
etc. also started more post holes

Sunday May 26 1889  
Hot Hitched up Jem a. Mag.  
and Took Ida to see Mrs

on our place across the River

Manly - Found a dead mare of  
Devine's across the river. Fred got  
the horses up in eve. Express looking  
fat and well, making bag

Mild but Windy - chores Fred got up horses and drove wild stock off we hitched May & Jem to the dead mare across the river and hauled her out in sage brush - hauled some posts to upper garden and placed them  
Went across river with Attie and George to look at land found Bess in bad fix on the river We got her out, No colt from Syp

Friday May 31

Warm. Pleasant. Fixed Grade fence

Thursday Nov 14

Windy made a door & Fred  
went back horseback to stay at  
the place on account of vegetables

Friday Nov 15

Hitched up four horses and went  
up for load of vegetables got up  
there at dusk started at 9<sup>o</sup>

Saturday Nov 16 -

Pleasant, cloudy. Loaded up all Potatoes & Turnips, chickens & cap and came home to Grass island

Sunday Nov 17

Cool Cloudy Mrs Parker here, I had been sick through night, Fred & Ida unloaded Turnips & buried same I worked on door lock & window

Monday Nov 18 - 89

Squally. Finished door lock &c and also put on last of shingles burned bal of Potatoes & beets Showers & snow & Hail - the drawing for premium for the Examiner takes place today

Tuesday Nov 19-89  
Squally & cold - Fred rode after  
stock all up but old Blackey  
brought up a span of horses and  
I took down bed and Plough  
to Kelso House

Wednesday Nov 20

Mild but stormy Fred went  
after a load of sage brush  
I did carpenter work. Beds  
took some ~~way~~ to Kelso.

Thursday Nov 21

Snowing - Ida & Fred went  
down for water in morning  
I fixed bunk for Fred & who  
went down with me for water  
at dusk in a heavy snow  
storm

Friday Nov 22.

Stormy Cold, a Windy chores  
Fixed around house also a  
Warm Coop for chickens wrote a  
letter to Dick

Saturday Nov 23

Windy but Mild Burned the Potatoes  
deeper in Corral and commenced  
the Wall - Fred went up to old  
place for a load - J Kelso left  
some Beef here.

Sunday Nov 24

Heavy frost in night - chores  
chop wood work on Wall feed  
Calves & Colt (Sukie) who will suck  
his Mother Fred got home late  
with bag of grain & vegetables the  
Beets were mostly spoiled and his  
Fish Pole Stolen

Monday Nov 25, 1889

mild but showery. The snow has  
been gone in the valley for some day.  
Ida went down to Mrs Parker for  
milk. Fred attended to stock and  
I worked on Mill between showers -

Tuesday Nov 26.

Mild. Got up all the stock and  
horses. We were nearly out of  
beef we killed Old Blacky  
today - rather a tough job and  
got the beef up to house by eve.

Wednesday Nov 27

Cool. Cloudy hung the beef and  
put the bal of Berks underground  
unloaded grain and took wagon  
down to R. Hay corral

Thursday Nov 28.

Mild but Cloudy. Watered Stock  
got up Mag & Cliff and having  
put Hay in Wagon took Ida &  
two chicks up to Dr Embree's -  
where we stayed all night -  
Fred stayed home to take care of  
place & stock (Henry sick)

Friday Nov 29 - 89

I went to Burns for Mail, supplies,  
&c. paid for Pump ~~1425~~ Bot sugar  
salt hams &c stayed over night at  
Racine 1<sup>00</sup> got a young sow from  
him in place of Boar and brought  
it down saw some card playing  
in Eve -

Saturday Nov 30. 89

Mild cloudy. Up early and fed horses - loaded up Pig &c and all, gave Spot away to a big Indian started and got to Dr Emmons' about 2 P.M.

had dinner and came home with Ida's Children - Found Fred on freight M W & Co goods home

Sunday Dec 1st

Cool cloudy Went over to Tom Parker's N.E. Cut up and salted Meat Fred sick Watered stock &c

Monday Dec 2nd

Cool cloudy Salted bal of Beef

I went and helped fix up  
Gordon's Hay Corral with J.  
Kelso. Poor J. Parker was  
taken to insane asylum yester-

Tuesday Dec 3.

Cool Cloudy Fred went for  
Sagebrush and I worked on  
Gordon's corral and then on the  
well - which I put down  
about 10 feet - Fred got home  
in good season Henry cross

Wednesday Dec 4

Cool Cloudy Fred & I worked on  
well chorn &c

Thursday Dec 5<sup>89</sup>

Cool Cloudy worked on feed  
corral (by Fred & I) and with  
Ida's help brought up 3 calves  
and fed them.

Friday Dec 6.

Mild but cloudy worked  
on House floor, & well which  
is nearly finished - Gyp Jan  
& Duke came up in evening  
watered them.

Saturday Dec 7.

Mild Worked on Water trough  
Fred rounded up stock - all  
up but Lady cant find her  
around here

Sunday Dec 8.

Stormy Wind & squalls  
Fred rode Dick to old place  
to look for Lady - Joe Parker  
was here with family, two  
dogs, a Pig, I fixed the meal  
and worked on trough. Fred  
did not come home.

Monday Dec 9 -

Cool & Stormy got up stock  
no Lady, finished up Hay &  
Feed corrals - Fred came home  
but no Lady -

Tuesday Dec 10

Stormy Fred went below to  
look for Lady I dug Post hole  
at mill and went for Muck.

Wednesday Dec 11, 89

Stormy & heavy snow storm  
during the night dug Post hole  
for Calf corral & Ida's clothes  
line posts - All the stock except  
Lady up and all the horses  
Fred went down to look for  
Lady - N.G.

Thursday Dec 12

Stormy snow. Fred got up  
all the stock except Lady  
We went out in sage brush  
for a load of same - home  
at dusk Fed stock, horses  
bedded the pigs cold nights

Friday Dec 13

Cool - Snow about 4 to 5 inches  
Worked on Calf corral and  
Watered Stock &c at Kelso's  
Fred went to Cook for Lady  
at old place chickens lots of  
trouble the snow bothers them  
Lots of wild cattle around  
down here by the snow

Saturday Dec 14.

Mild but cold nights, snow stays  
Worked on Calf and Horse corral  
Fed Stock &c Fred got home  
after dark heard of Lady, all  
horses around except Mag - all  
Stock except Lady.)

Sunday Dec 15. 89

Foggy and Cool - Fred went up to look for Lady - Joe Parker came with Family said he saw Lady with Calf Saturday Eve at old place - I went down to look for horses to go after her but no horses however some of them came up at eve and were corralled. Fred not home

Monday Dec 16 -

Foggy and cold Hitched up Jim & Mag and went after a jag of Hay, Cattle bad. unloaded part of Hay and then started to find Lady

and calf - Met Fred with them beyond Horro's we put the calf in wagon and trot them home put stock in corral and fed them Lady's calf is a very pretty heifer called Pansey supposed to be one week old

Tuesday Dec 17

Snowing hard till noon, wrote a letter to Ira Dorman - stopped snowing worked on Calf corral which we finished and also on Horse corral till dusk Chopped wood, Lady giving very little milk

Wednesday Dec 18. 89

Cloudy & Cold - Fred and me  
hauled a wagon of Hay - Got  
the Horses up and Watered stock  
and worked on corral took steers

Thursday Dec 19 <sup>of</sup>

Cold Windy and Snow - Fred and  
me went for a load of sagebrush  
All stock up but three and  
all the Horses a cold day

Friday Dec 20.

Cool but fine - Fred drove  
Cattle and horses to water  
and then hunted up the those  
missing steers - I worked on the  
corral and well fence

corrall and well fenced  
at eve all the cattle and  
horses were corralled tonight

Saturday Dec 21

Blizzard snow and wind. Chose  
most letters and fed stock

Sunday Dec 22.

Cold Morning but Moderated. Fred  
and I got up a jag of Hay and  
I started for Embree and Burn  
with May & Chief, found the Roads  
very bad and had to break the way -  
got up to old place and put up  
the team and went up to Embree's  
outpost - H Campbell was there and  
we slept there in a bed. a very  
uncomfortable night

Monday Dec 23. 89

Cold Morning - I concluded to spare  
the Horses and go to Rumm when the  
roads were broke so loaded up the  
sled and some other traps including  
a Haw Bent sent to Ida for Xmas.  
and came home

Tuesday Dec 24.

Moderate - I fed watered stock and  
I worked on Horse corral

Wednesday Dec 25

Moderate Xmas day chores and  
stayed home made Handles for  
axes and Hatchet

Thursday Dec 26

Moderate Got up bag of Hay

watered horses greased axles  
and got ready for a trip to old  
place for hay rack &c

Friday Dec 27-

Moderate but stormy snow.  
Hitched up four horses and  
Fred and I went up to old  
place and loaded on the hay  
rack Post rack and little snow  
Horses &c got home at dusk  
Fred stock and horses, supper

Saturday Dec 28

Cold & stormy wind &c. Fixed  
rail around well Fred watered  
stock. Hitched up four horses  
and went after load of hay

Sunday Dec 29. 89.

Cool & Cloudy Unloaded Hay  
Hitched up four Horses and  
Went after load of sage brush  
Thompson also after a load.  
Hoover took his sheep out in  
sage brush Hay gave out  
Home at dusk Fed stock &c

Monday Dec 30.

Cool & Windy - commenced a  
hole for the smoke house  
Fed Watered stock, Kelso has  
returned sleigh - Worked on  
Horse corral - Fed, stock and  
Horses all here tonight

Tuesday Dec 31 -

Cold & snow with wind & finished  
up smoke house in good shape  
I whittled pins for Horse corral  
a stormy day - Fed stock at 8<sup>00</sup>  
all here - in eve Ida Fred and  
I played cards till late and  
talked of our folks so far away  
Ida's tooth growing
