



Library2Go eBooks and Audiobooks For Kindle Fire (color screen)

The Kindle Fire is compatible with Kindle Books, Adobe EPUB, and MP3 audiobooks.

Borrowing and downloading a Kindle book

1. Open the browser on your Kindle Fire and visit Library2Go: library2go.overdrive.com
2. Tap **Sign In** near the upper-right corner, tap to select **LEO Listens - Libraries of Eastern Oregon**, and enter your library card number and password. Tap the green **Sign In** button.
3. On the Library2Go website, look for a title that's available to borrow. You can:
 - Browse the titles on the home page
 - Use the menu at the top of the page to browse subjects or collections
 - Type keywords in the search box.
 - Search tip: Tap **Search** then **Advanced** to refine a search. To find titles available for immediate checkout, select **Available Now** under Availability. Select **Kindle Book** under Formats.
4. When you find a title that looks interesting, tap **Borrow** then tap **Go to Loans**. Or, tap **more** to view the title's details page first.
5. Your library loans shelf will open, displaying the title(s) you've borrowed. From here, tap **Download** and select **Kindle Book**.
6. You will be directed to Amazon.com. Tap the yellow **Get Library Book** button to complete checkout on Amazon's website.
7. Sign in to your Amazon.com account. Choose the device you wish to read on and tap **Continue**.
8. A message from Amazon.com will read: *"Your digital library book will be delivered the next time [your device] syncs."*
 - Connect your Kindle to a Wi-Fi signal. If you do not have access to a Wi-Fi signal, follow the *Download via USB* instructions in the box below.* Amazon does not permit syncing library books using the Kindle's 3G connection.
 - When your Kindle syncs, find the title on the home screen carousel or under Books.

Returning a Kindle book early

The book will automatically return on the due date, but you may want to return it early.

1. Go to Amazon.com and log in to your account. Tap **Accounts & Lists** in the tool bar.
2. Under Your Account, select **Your Content and Devices**. You will see a list of books you own or have borrowed.
3. To the left of the title you wish to return, tap the **Actions (...)** box.
4. A menu will display – select **Return this book** then **Yes**.
5. If you'd like to remove it from your list, go to Actions again and select **Delete**.



Expand your choices with the OverDrive app

Gain access to everything compatible with the Kindle Fire including MP3 audiobooks and EPUB eBooks.

Get the Overdrive app

1. On your Kindle Fire, download the free **OverDrive** app from the **Store**.
2. Open the **OverDrive** app and follow the prompts to create an OverDrive account and log in. If you're under 13, select **I am under 13 years old** instead.
3. In the OverDrive app, tap **Add a title** then search for Eugene Public Library.
4. From the search results tap to select **LEO Listens - Libraries of Eastern Oregon**.
5. Tap the star to save to your library list. Tap **Oregon Digital Library Consortium** to start browsing.

Borrowing and Downloading using the OverDrive app

1. Open the **OverDrive** app.
2. Tap the three-bar **Home menu** icon in the top-left corner to see your library list.
3. Tap **Oregon Digital Library Consortium** to go to the digital collection website (Library2Go).
4. Tap **Sign In** and select **Oregon Digital Library Consortium** and choose **LEO Listens - Libraries of Eastern Oregon** as your library. Enter your library card number and password. Tap the green **Sign In** button.
5. To find a title that's available to borrow. You can:
 - Browse the titles on the home page
 - Use the menu at the top of the page to browse subjects or collections
 - Type keywords in the search box.
 - Search tip: Tap **Search** then **Advanced** to refine a search. To find titles available for immediate checkout, select **Available Now** under Availability. Select **Kindle Book** under Formats.
6. When you find a title that looks interesting, tap **Borrow** then **Go to Loans**. Or, tap **more** to view the title's details page first.
7. Your library loans shelf will open displaying the title(s) you've borrowed. From here, tap **Download** and select **EPUB eBook** or **MP3 Audiobook**.
8. Once the title downloads, you need to go to your Bookshelf in the app to read it or listen to it. Tap the three-bar menu icon, then tap **Bookshelf**.
9. Tap the cover image to enjoy your downloaded book.

Returning an EPUB eBook or MP3 audiobook early

Books will automatically expire on the due date, but you may want to return them early for others to enjoy. There are no overdue fines with Library2Go.

1. Open the **Overdrive** app.
2. Tap **Home menu** icon.
3. Tap **Bookshelf**.
4. Tap and hold the cover image.
5. Tap **Return/Delete**.

* (Optional) Download via USB from Amazon



Follow these steps if you choose to transfer to your Kindle via USB:

1. Turn on your Kindle and connect it to your computer with a USB cord.
2. Tap **Download now**.
3. You will be prompted to *Open* or *Save* the file. Next to the word *Save*, a small arrow will display *Save As*. Select **Save As** and then find your Kindle in the list of locations on your computer.
4. Tap **Kindle**, and then double-tap the **Documents folder** below it. Tap **Save**. The file will now download to your Kindle. Safely remove the Kindle from your computer, and go to your Kindle's home page to find your book
5. If something didn't work correctly, you can repeat this download step by going to **Manage Your Kindle** at Amazon.com. Tap the **Actions** button next to the book. Choose **Download and transfer via USB**.
